The same seven species will continue for our 2007 Trophy Fish of the Year Program. As of 05/25/07 4 Winter Flounder, 3 Bluefish, 2 Stripers, 1 Weakfish, & 1 Sea Bass have been weighed in.

Blackfish
Bluefish
Fluke
Sea Bass
Striped Bass
Weakfish
Winter Flounder

The rules are simple: you have to catch a fish of the above species, take it to one of our official weigh stations to have it weighed and recorded on our official weigh-in forms. If you have weighed in the largest fish of a particular species for the calendar year 2007, then you win the FOY trophy for that species. Note: your dues have to be paid before you catch an eligible fish.

FISH WITH LEMON & EGG SAUCE by Flo Williams

Ingredients:

1 lb. fish filet, 1 cup water, 1 tsp. salt, dash pepper, 2 tbsp. olive oil, juice of 2 lemons, 2 eggs, fresh parsley

Instructions:

Place fish in a shallow pan. Add water, salt & oil. Cook in oven under medium heat for 10-12 minutes. Turn heat off. Beat eggs with lemon juice then add some hot juice from fish. Stir constantly until well mixed. Pour sauce over fish & add parsley, Serve hot or cold.

FISHING REPORT by Bill Jann & Bill Dabney

From my fishing log...due to the rotten weather this was the first trip of the year. Nice way to start!

Wednesday May 4, 2007 6:00am to 1:00pm

Went out with Captain Dave and Bill Dabney at 6:00am ... we were looking for Back Bay Bass, using live herring and jigs with Gulp! ... started out along the islands near the big windmills at Atlantic City ... got bites right away, on the incoming tide, some of the herring got bitten off by blues but we landed a 30" striper apiece ... Capt. Dave worked the jig/gulp combo and got several smaller bass ... the flats around there are 3 to 5 feet deep, but the currents have carved channels along the sod banks up to 25 feet deep ... the captain used a trolling motor to keep us in the channels as we drifted ... the bass were tentative on their bite today; we had a lot of hits that scaled the herring but didn't reach the hook ... later the bite slowed down so we worked our way northward and found a school of nice blues near Absecon Inlet ... they bit on both the herring and the jig/gulp combos ... all in all, it was a great way to start off the season, especially after all the miserable weather we'd been having ... didn't use the radio, so I don't know what else was going on, but there were only a small handful of other boats around

REMEMBER THE OLD DAYS? By George Fruh

VHFC members might enjoy this fishing report I saved from the July 6, 1985 SandPaper.

EDITOR'S NOTE: The writer of this column, Mr. Kunze, has a good point. Read the excerpt below. If it weren't for efforts 22 years ago, the fluke fishery might be extinct. Size & bag limitations are very difficult to stomach but they do work!

“Dormant Doormats”

The minimum size limit for fluke will be 12 inches starting July 15, 1985, and that is welcome news to thousands of sportsmen. Most people look with disdain at anyone who catches a fish that is too small to give a decent fight and too small to have enough meat on it to make it worth cleaning.

Now maybe after a few years of progressively lengthening the minimum size of fluke, we will again be able to catch some doormats. For those of you who do not know what a doormat is, it's an undersized fluke that was put back into the water and given a chance to grow up to be a 10 or 12 pounder or more. To many who always take but never return, this may sound like a lot of malarkey, but if you ever do catch a very large fluke which can range from 8 to 20 pounds you may have some regrets about the small fish that you have taken.

I can still recall many fluke fishing trips, mostly along the oceanfront on the old *Queen of Hearts*, when all fluke under 2 pounds were returned to the water, and today many dedicated fishermen still do that. I still think that a minimum size should be placed on weakfish and kingfish, which are still being taken when they are very small. I have caught weakfish that weighed up to 14 pounds and kingfish that were 21 inches long, which gave me a greater thrill than if I had caught 15 of each of the undersized ones. The small fish do not raise your status as a sportsman and do not provide a good meal. There are always those that will take anything that they can sink a hook into, which is why laws must be passed to protect nature's creatures so that they can reach an adult stage in life and reproduce. That way future generations can enjoy nature's bounty.

North & South Bay Tournament on June 23rd, 2007
